Warning

It is an offence under section 53(3) of the Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages (Scotland) Act 1965 for any person to pass as genuine any reproduction of an abbreviated certificate of birth if the certificate has not been either (a) issued by a local registration office and signed by the registrar authorised for this purpose; or (b) issued from the General Register Office and sealed or stamped with the seal of that Office.

Any person who falsifies or forges this certificate or knowingly uses or gives or sends to any person as genuine any false or forged certificate is liable to prosecution under section 53(1) of the said Act.

This certificate is evidence of an event recorded in a register of births. It is NOT evidence of the identity of the person presenting it.
