**The Pensions Compensation Board (Determinations  
and Review Procedure) Regulations 1997**

The Secretary of State for Social Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 78(8), 80(4) and 124(1) of, and paragraph 12 of Schedule 2 to, the Pensions Act 1995<sup>(1)</sup>, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, after consultation with the Council on Tribunals as required by section 8 of the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1992<sup>(2)</sup>, by this instrument, which is made before the end of the period of 6 months beginning with the coming into force of the provisions of Part I of the Pensions Act 1995 by virtue of which it is made<sup>(3)</sup>, hereby makes the following Regulations—

- (2) 1992 c. 53. See paragraph 21(d) of Schedule 3 to the Pensions Act 1995 which adds the Pensions Compensation Board to the list of tribunals under the direct supervision of the Council on Tribunals in paragraph 35 of Schedule 1 to the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1992.
- (3) See section 120(2)(c) of the Pensions Act 1995. This provides that the requirement to consult does not apply where regulations are made before the end of 6 months beginning with the coming into force of the provisions of Part I of the Pensions Act 1995 by virtue of which they are made.
