PART IX

CONTROL OF COMPOUND FEEDING STUFFS

Manufacture of compound feeding stuffs containing additives referred to in Chapter II(a) of the Annex to Directive 95/69

78. No person shall manufacture, with a view to putting it into circulation, a compound feeding stuff which contains an additive of any kind (other than copper, selenium, vitamin A and vitamin D) referred to in Chapter II(a) of the Annex, but does not contain an additive of any kind referred to in Chapter I.2(a) of the Annex, except on a UK registered or permitted Article 7.2(c)(A) establishment.
