The person making the application is referred to in this form as the Sponsor. The completed form should be sent to the Sponsor's local chief officer of police. Firearms to which section 1 applies include any smooth bore gun which has a barrel with a length of less than 60.96 cm (24 inches) or a bore greater than 5.08 cm (two inches) in diameter, or which has a non-detachable magazine capable of holding more than two cartridges, or a detachable magazine. It is an offence for any person knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement for the purpose of procuring the grant of a permit.
