TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT

The Social Security (Welfare to Work) Regulations 1998

Made - - - - *10th September 1998*
Laid before Parliament *14th September 1998*
Coming into force - - *5th October 1998*

The Secretary of State for Social Security, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 30C(4) (b), 47(6), 68(11)(b)(i), (ca) and (cc), 123(1)(d) and (e), 131(10), 135(1), 137(1), 171A, 171C, 171D, 171E, 171G(2) and 175(1) to (4) of, and paragraph 1 of Schedule 11 to, the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992^{M1}, sections 4 and 12 of the Social Security (Incapacity for Work) Act 1994^{M2}, section 4(5) of the Jobseekers Act 1995^{M3} and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, after consultation with organisations appearing to him to be representative of the authorities concerned^{M4}, and agreement by the Social Security Advisory Committee that proposals to make these Regulations should not be referred to it^{M5}, hereby makes the following Regulations:
