The District of South Lakeland (Electoral Changes) Order 1998

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the District of South Lakeland (Electoral Changes) Order 1998.

(2) This Order shall come into force for the purposes of articles 2, 3 and 6 on 6th May 1999, except that for the purpose of all proceedings preliminary or relating to an election to be held on or after that date this Order shall come into force on the day after the day on which it is made.

(3) For the purposes of article 4 this Order shall come into force on 2nd May 2002, except that for the purpose of all proceedings preliminary or relating to an election of a parish councillor of the parish of Kendal to be held on or after that date this Order shall come into force on 10th October 2001.

(4) For the purposes of article 5 this Order shall come into force on 4th May 2000, except that for the purposes of all proceedings preliminary or relating to an election of a parish councillor of the parish of Ulverston to be held on or after that date this Order shall come into force on 10th October 1999.

(5) For the purposes of article 7 this Order shall come into force on 1st May 2003, except that for the purpose of all proceedings preliminary or relating to an election of a parish councillor of the parish of Pennington to be held on or after that date this Order shall come into force on 10th October 2002.

(6) In this Order—

“the district” means the district of South Lakeland;

“existing”, in relation to a ward, means the ward as it exists on the date this Order is made; and any reference to “the map” is a reference to the map prepared by the Department of the Environment, Transport and the Regions marked “Map of the District of South Lakeland (Electoral Changes) Order 1998”, and deposited in accordance with regulation 27 of the Local Government Changes for England Regulations 1994⁽¹⁾.
