AMENDMENTS TO STATEMENTS OF CASE

**Power of court to disallow amendments made without permission**

**17.2.**—(1) If a party has amended [<sup>F1</sup>their] statement of case where permission of the court was not required, the court may disallow the amendment.

(2) A party may apply to the court for an order under paragraph (1) within 14 days of service of a copy of the amended statement of case on [<sup>F2</sup>them].
