GENERAL RULES ABOUT APPLICATIONS FOR COURT ORDERS

What an application notice must include

- 23.6 An application notice must state—
 - (a) what order the applicant is seeking; and
 - (b) briefly, why the applicant is seeking the order.

(Part 22 requires an application notice to be verified by a statement of truth if the applicant wishes to rely on matters set out in his application notice as evidence)
