64.1.—(1) This Part contains rules—

- (a) in Section I, about claims relating to—
 - (i) the administration of estates of deceased persons, and
 - (ii) trusts; and

(2) In this Part and [^{F2}Practice Directions 64A and 64B], where appropriate, references to trustees include executors and administrators.

(3) All proceedings in the High Court to which this Part applies must be brought in the Chancery Division.]
