Applications by local authorities for power of arrest to be attached to an injunction

### [F1Scope of this Section and interpretation

**65.8.**—(1) This Section applies to applications by local authorities under section 91(3) of the Anti-social Behaviour Act 2003(1) for a power of arrest to be attached to an injunction.

(Section 91 of the 2003 Act applies to proceedings in which a local authority is a party by virtue of section 222 of the Local Government Act 1972(2) (power of local authority to bring, defend or appear in proceedings for the promotion or protection of the interests of inhabitants in their area)

(2) In this Section "the 2003 Act" means the Anti-social Behaviour Act 2003.]
