RESPONDING TO PARTICULARS OF CLAIM—GENERAL

**Defence, admission or acknowledgment of service**

**9.2** When particulars of claim are served on a defendant, the defendant may—

- (a) file or serve an admission in accordance with Part 14;
- (b) file a defence in accordance with Part 15,

(or do both, if he admits only part of the claim); or

- (c) file an acknowledgment of service in accordance with Part 10.
