**The Water Supply (Water Fittings)  
(Amendment) Regulations 1999**

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions and the Secretary of State for Wales acting jointly, in exercise of their powers under sections 74 and 213(2) of the Water Industry Act 1991<sup>(1)</sup> and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Water Supply (Water Fittings) (Amendment) Regulations 1999 and shall come into force on 1st July 1999.

**Amendment of the Water Supply (Water Fittings) Regulations 1999**

- 2.—(1) The Water Supply (Water Fittings) Regulations 1999<sup>(2)</sup> are amended as follows.
- (2) In regulation 5(3)(d) (notification) for “paragraph (1)(d)(iii)–(v) or (1)(e)” substitute “paragraph 4(a), (c), (h) or 5 in the Table”.
- (3) In regulation 6(2) (contractor’s certificate) for “paragraph 5” substitute “regulation 5(1)”.
- (4) In regulation 10(1) (enforcement) for “Part I” substitute “Part II”.
- (5) In Schedule 2 (requirements for water fittings)–
- (a) in paragraph 14(2) (prevention of cross connection to unwholesome water), at the end insert “unless a device for preventing backflow is installed in accordance with paragraph 15.”
