**The Education (Code of Practice on LEA – School Relations)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 85(5) of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998<sup>(a)</sup> the Secretary of State for Wales hereby makes the following Order:–

**Citation**

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Education (Code of Practice on LEA – School Relations) (Appointed Day) (Wales) Order 1999.

**2.** 30th June 1999 is hereby appointed as the day on which the Code of Practice on LEA – School Relations<sup>(b)</sup> issued pursuant to Section 127 of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998 on 15th June 1999 shall come into effect.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order appoints 30th June 1999 as the day on which the Code of Practice on LEA – School Relations issued under section 127 of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998 (“the 1998 Act”) takes effect. This Code provides practical guidance with a view to securing effective relationships between local education authorities in Wales and the schools maintained by them—

- (a) in relation to promoting high standards of education in such schools; and
- (b) in relation to the discharge of “relevant” functions of such authorities in relation to such schools (as listed in section 127(6) of the 1998 Act).
