The University College London Hospitals National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 1999

Made - - - - *23rd August 1999*

Coming into force - - *2nd September 1999*

The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 126(3) of the National Health Service Act 1977⁽¹⁾ and section 5(1) of the National Health Service and Community Care Act 1990⁽²⁾ and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, after completion of the consultation prescribed under section 5(2) of the latter Act⁽³⁾, considering it appropriate that the functions of the trust should include functions in relation to the provision of services for one or more Health Authorities⁽⁴⁾, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the University College London Hospitals National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 1999 and shall come into force on 2nd September 1999.

Amendment of NHS trust Establishment Order

2. For article 3 of the University College London Hospitals National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Order 1996⁽⁵⁾ (functions of the trust) there shall be substituted the following article—

“Nature and functions of the trust

3.—(1) The trust is established for the purposes specified in section 5(1)(b) of the Act.

(2) The trust’s functions shall be to provide and manage hospital accommodation and services (including the management of its teaching and research facilities) and to provide and manage other establishments and facilities at:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends the Order (“the Establishment Order”) which established the University College London Hospitals National Health Service Trust (“the Trust”).

The Establishment Order is amended to confer on the trust the purposes specified in section 5(1)(b) of the National Health Service and Community Care Act 1990 to provide and manage hospitals or other establishments or facilities. The functions of the trust are further amended so that the trust is also entitled to provide and manage services from additional sites.
