# The Building Societies (Nominations for Directors' Election) Order 1999

Made - - - - - 5th November 1999

Laid before Parliament 10th November 1999

Coming into force - - 1st December 1999

The Building Societies Commission, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 61(4) of the Building Societies Act 1986(a), hereby makes the following Order:

#### Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Building Societies (Nominations for Directors' Election) Order 1999 and shall come into force on 1st December 1999.

### Amendment of section 61 of the Building Societies Act 1986

- **2.** Subsection (1) of section 61 of the Building Societies Act 1986(**b**) (directors: supplementary provisions as to elections, etc.) is amended as follows—
  - (a) in paragraph (a) for "10" there is substituted "50";
  - (b) in paragraph (b) for "20" there is substituted "100";
  - (c) in paragraph (c) for "30" there is substituted "150";
  - (d) in paragraph (d) for "40" there is substituted "200";
  - (e) in paragraph (e) for "50" there is substituted "250".

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This Order amends section 61(1) of the Building Societies Act 1986 by making a fivefold increase in the minimum number of members whom a building society may require under its rules to nominate a person for election as a director. The minimum number is on a scale between 50 and 250 depending on the size of the society.
