# 1999 No. 3178

## The Social Security Act 1998 (Commencement No. 12 and Consequential and Transitional Provisions) Order 1999

### Appointed day

2.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2) below, 29th November 1999 is the day appointed for the coming into force of the—

- (a) the provisions specified in Schedule 1 to this Order; and
- (b) sections 1 and 4 to 7 in relation to—
  - (i) statutory sick pay under Part XI of the Contributions and Benefits Act; and
  - (ii) statutory maternity pay under Part XII of that Act,in so far as those provisions are not already in force.

(2) Paragraph (1)(a) above shall not apply in relation to—

- (a) housing benefit;
- (b) council tax benefit; nor
- (c) decisions to which article 4(6) of the Social Security Contributions (Transfer of Functions, etc.) Act 1999 (Commencement No. 1 and Transitional Provisions) Order 1999 <sup>F1</sup> applies.

(3) 31st March 2000 is the day appointed for the coming into force of paragraph 10 of Schedule 1 (appeal tribunals: supplementary provisions) and sections 5(3) and 7(7) in so far as they relate to it.
