Transitional Provisions

- **4.** Until the coming into force of section 77 the Second Schedule (Constitution of Youth Courts) to the Children and Young Persons Act 1933(1) shall have effect as if—
 - (a) the heading "Youth court panels" were deleted, and
 - (b) for the words "metropolitan stipendiary magistrate" in each place where they occur there were substitued the words "District Judge (Magistrates' Courts)".
