**The Birmingham Specialist Community Health National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 2000**

*Made* - - - - 27th July 2000

*Coming into force* - - 7th August 2000

The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 126(3) of the National Health Service Act 1977<sup>(1)</sup> and section 5(1) of the National Health Service and Community Care Act 1990<sup>(2)</sup> and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, after completion of the consultation prescribed under section 5(2) of the latter Act<sup>(3)</sup>, hereby makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Birmingham Specialist Community Health National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 2000 and shall come into force on 7th August 2000.

**Amendment of NHS trust Establishment Order**

2. In article 4 of the Birmingham Specialist Community Health National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Order 1999<sup>(4)</sup>, for “5 non-executive” substitute “6 non-executive”.
