The Supreme Court Fees (Amendment No. 2) Order 2000

Amendments to the 1999 Fees Order

12. For columns 1 and 2 in fee 9 there shall be substituted—

Number and description of fee	Amount of fee
(a) Where in an appeal notice permission to appeal or an extension of time for appealing is applied for (or both are applied for)— <ul style="list-style-type: none">• on filing an appellant’s notice, or• where, the respondent is appealing, on filing a respondent’s notice	£100
(b) Where permission to appeal is not required or has been granted by the lower court— <ul style="list-style-type: none">• on filing an appellant’s notice, or• on filing a respondent’s notice where the respondent is appealing	£200
(c) On the appellant filing an appeal questionnaire (unless the appellant has paid fee 9.1(b)), or on the respondent filing an appeal questionnaire (unless the respondent has paid fee 9.1(b))	£200
9.2 On filing a respondent’s notice where the respondent wishes to ask the appeal court to uphold the order of the lower court for reasons different from or additional to those given by the lower court	£100
9.3 On filing an application notice	£100
