- 2. In Fee No. 8.2 in the Schedule to the Public Record Office (Fees) (No. 2) Regulations 2000(**b**), for:

"Where no negative exists, for a photographic service,

there shall be substituted:

"Where no negative exists, for a photographic service, per negative
