**The Northern Ireland Act 1998 (Designation of Public
Authorities) Order 2001**

Made - - - - - *4th April 2001*

Coming into force - - - *5th April 2001*

Whereas a draft of this Order has been approved by each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 75(3)(a) and (d) of the Northern Ireland Act 1998(a), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Northern Ireland Act 1998 (Designation of Public Authorities) Order 2001 and shall come into force on the day after the day on which it is made.
2. The departments, corporations and bodies listed in Schedule 1 to this Order (being departments, corporations and bodies listed in Schedule 2 to the Parliamentary Commissioner Act 1967(b)) are hereby designated for the purposes of section 75 of the Northern Ireland Act 1998.
3. The persons listed in Schedule 2 to this Order are hereby designated for the purposes of section 75 of the Northern Ireland Act 1998.

to the need to promote equality of opportunity; and
to the desirability of promoting good relations between people of different religious belief, political opinion or racial group.
