 - (f) section 31;
 - (g) section 32;
 - (h) section 36;
 - (i) in Schedule 8, paragraphs 1 to 5 and paragraph 7; and
 - (j) in Schedule 9—
 - (i) in Part 1, the entries relating to the Financial Services Act 1986 and to the Banking Act 1987; and
 - (ii) Part 2.
