

SCHEDULE 1

MODIFICATIONS OF THE REGISTERED DESIGNS ACT 1949 AS IT HAS EFFECT IN THE ISLE OF MAN

- 36.—**(1) In section 44(1)(1) (interpretation)—
- (a) omit the definitions of “article”, “artistic work”, “corresponding design” and “set of articles”;
 - (b) in the definition of “design”, for “section 1(1)” substitute “section 1(2)”;
 - (c) at the appropriate places insert—
 - ““complex product” has the meaning assigned to it by section 1(3) of this Act;”;
 - ““national unregistered design right” means design right within the meaning of the Design Right Act 1991 (an Act of Tynwald)(2);”;
 - ““product” has the meaning assigned to it by section 1(3) of this Act;”.
- (2) After section 44(1) insert—
- “(1A) References in this section to the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988 are to that Act as it has effect in England and Wales.”
- (3) Omit section 44(2) and (3).
- (4) In section 44(4) for the words from “section”, where it first appears, to “Act” substitute “section 14 of this Act”.
