**The County of Cumbria (Electoral Changes) (Amendment)  
Order 2001**

*Made - - - - - 7th March 2001*

*Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)*

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 17 and 26 of the Local Government Act 1992(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

**Citation, commencement and interpretation**

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the County of Cumbria (Electoral Changes) (Amendment) Order 2001.

(2) This Order shall come into force on the day after that on which it is made.

**Amendment of Order**

2. The County of Cumbria (Electoral Changes) Order 2000(b) is amended, in column (2) of the Schedule under the heading, “In the district of Eden”,—

- (a) by the deletion of “Crosby Ravensworth” in the division of “Kirkby Stephen”; and
- (b) in respect of the column (1) entry “Eden Lakes”, by the insertion of the ward of “Crosby Ravensworth”.
