## SCHEDULE 1

JUSTICES OF THE PEACE ACT 1997 ETC.: TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS AND SAVINGS

7. Article 6A of the Magistrates' Courts (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(1) shall not apply to proceedings commenced before 1st April 2001 in respect of any act or omission of a resident magistrate, justice of the peace or clerk of petty sessions in the execution (or purported execution) of his duty—

- (a) as such a magistrate or justice, or
- (b) as such a clerk exercising, by virtue of any statutory provision, any of the functions of a magistrates' court.
