## LOCAL GOVERNMENT, ENGLAND

The Borough of Burnley (Electoral Changes) (Amendment) Order 2002

Made - - - 2nd December 2002 Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

The Electoral Commission(1), in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 17(2) and 26(3) of the Local Government Act 1992, hereby make the following Order:

#### Citation and commencement

**1.**—(1) This Order may be cited as the Borough of Burnley (Electoral Changes) (Amendment) Order 2002.

(2) This Order shall come into force on the day after that on which it is made.

## Amendment to the 2001 Order

2.—(1) The Borough of Burnley (Electoral Changes) Order 2001(4) shall be amended as follows.

(2) In article 3, there shall be inserted after the end of (3), and before the beginning of (4), the following:

"(3A) Of the councillors elected in 2002 for any ward of the borough, one shall retire in 2003, one in 2004 and one in 2006."
