- 1. This Order may be cited as the Proceeds of Crime Act 2002 (Commencement No. 2) Order 2002.
- **2.** Part 1 of the Proceeds of Crime Act 2002 (sections 1 to 5, together with Schedule 1) shall come into force on 13th January 2003.

This Order brings into force, on 13th January 2003, Part 1 of the Proceeds of Crime Act 2002, including all of Schedule 1 to the Proceeds of Crime Act 2002.

NOTE AS TO EARLIER COMMENCEMENT ORDERS

S.I.2002/3015 provided that the following provisions of the Proceeds of Crime Act 2002 are to come into force on 30th December 2002—

- (a) section 89 (Procedure on appeal to the Court of Appeal) (for the purposes of making secondary legislation);

- (l) paragraphs 25(1) and (2)(a) and 36 of Schedule 11 (in part);
- (m) in Schedule 12, in the entry relating to the Drug Trafficking Act 1994, the entry in the second column concerning sections 1 to 54 of that Act (in part).
