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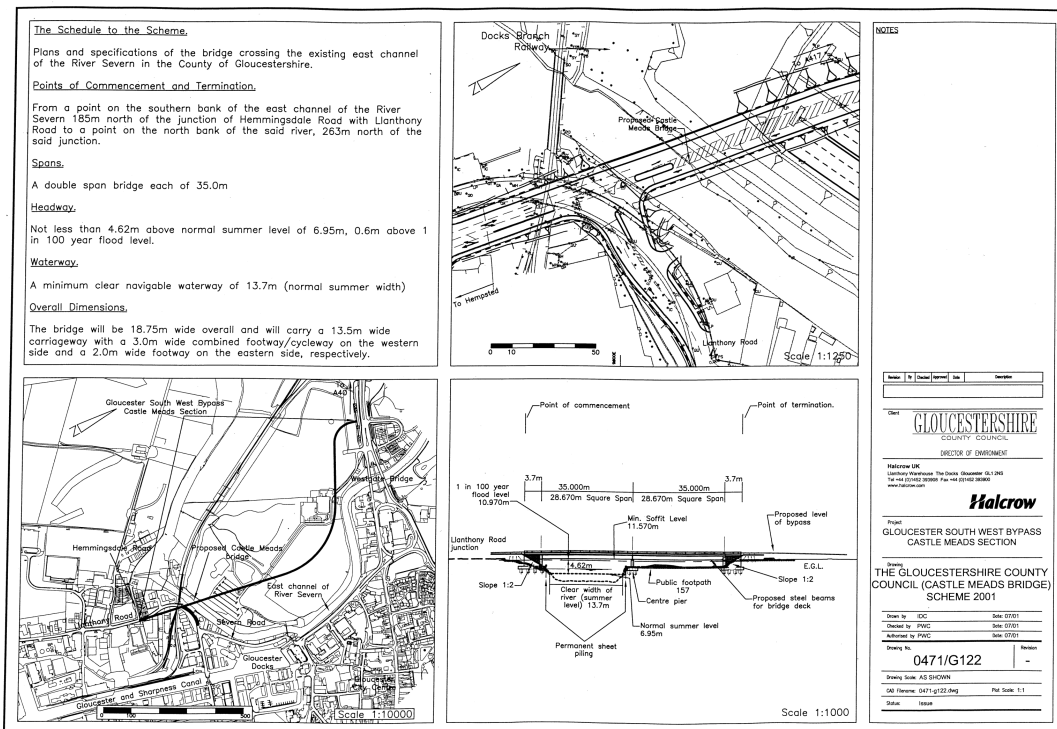
THE SCHEDULE

THE GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CASTLE MEADS BRIDGE) SCHEME 2001

The Gloucestershire County Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) make this Scheme in exercise of their powers under Section 106(3) of the Highways Act 1980 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf:

1. The Council are authorised to construct over the navigable waters of the River Severn the bridge specified in the Schedule to this Scheme as part of the highway which they are proposing to construct from a point 188 metres north of the junction of Hemmingsdale Road with Llanthony Road northwards to the A417 Over Causeway 275 metres west of Westgate Bridge, in the City of Gloucester in the said County.

2. This Scheme may be cited as the “Gloucestershire County Council (Castle Meads Bridge) Scheme 2001”.
