APPEALS TO THE COMMISSION UNDER THE 1997 ACT

Variation of grounds of appeal

11.—(1) Subject to section 85(2) of the 2002 Act⁽¹⁾, the appellant may vary the grounds of appeal only with the leave of the Commission.

(2) The appellant must file any proposed variation of the grounds of appeal with the Commission and serve a copy on the Secretary of State.
