**The Urban Waste Water Treatment (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2003**

**Duty to maintain up to date information about sensitive areas and high natural dispersion areas**

3.—(1) The appropriate authority and [<sup>F1</sup>the appropriate agency] shall each ensure that their website makes available to the public—

- (a) maps of all areas of water currently identified as a sensitive area or as a high natural dispersion area; and
- (b) the dates on which any area of water was identified as a sensitive area or high natural dispersion area, or ceased to be so identified.

(2) [<sup>F1</sup>The appropriate agency] shall keep available at its principal office and at each of its principal regional offices for inspection by the public at all reasonable times free of charge—

- (a) the maps showing sensitive areas and high natural dispersion areas deposited with [<sup>F1</sup>the appropriate agency] for the purposes of regulation 2 of these Regulations (together with any maps previously deposited for the purposes of regulation 3 of the principal Regulations); and
- (b) the information mentioned in paragraph (1)(b) in documentary form.
