**The London Thames Gateway Development Corporation (Area and Constitution) Order 2004**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 134(1) and 135 of, and paragraph 1 of Schedule 26 to, the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980<sup>(1)</sup>, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order—
