The Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (Establishment of Conservation Board) Order 2004

PART I

Introductory

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (Establishment of Conservation Board) Order 2004 and shall come into force on the fourteenth day after the day on which it is made.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“the 1972 Act” means the Local Government Act 1972 ^{F1};

“the 1989 Act” means the Local Government and Housing Act 1989 ^{F2};

“the 2000 Act” means the Countryside and Rights of Way Act 2000;

“the Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty” means the area designated on 26th May 1964 by the Chilterns Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty (Designation) Order 1964 and varied on 14th November 1988 by the Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (Designation) Variation Order 1988 ^{F3};

“the Board” means the Conservation Board for the Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty as established by article 3;

“the establishment day” means 14th December 2004; and

“the operative day” means the 1st February 2005.
