- **1.** This Order may be cited as the Discharge of Fines by Unpaid Work (Pilot Schemes) Order 2004 and shall come into force on 21st September 2004.
- **2.** Schedule 6 to the Courts Act 2003 (Discharge of Fines by Unpaid Work) is to have effect in relation to the petty sessions areas(**b**) specified in the Schedule to this Order for the period beginning on 21st September 2004 and ending on 31st March 2005.
