 - (a) section 65 of the Act; and
 - (b) in Schedule 7 to the Act, paragraphs 10, 11 and 24(3);

- (2) Regulations made under section 58 of the Local Government Finance Act 1988(3) shall continue to have effect in relation to any relevant period ending before 1st April 2005 as if—
 - (a) section 65 of the Act; and
 - (b) in Schedule 7 to the Act, paragraphs 10, 11 and 24(3);

had not been commenced.

- (3) Section 138 of and Schedules 7 and 8 to the Local Government Finance Act 1988 shall continue to have effect in relation to any non-domestic rating multiplier for any financial year ending before 1st April 2005, as if—
 - (a) section 62 of the Act;
 - (b) in Schedule 7 to the Act, paragraphs 20, 21, 25(4), (5) and (6), and 26(3);
 - (c) in Schedule 8 to the Act, the repeals of paragraph 6(3) of Schedule 10 to, and paragraph 84(2)(b) of Schedule 13 to, the Local Government Finance Act 1992,
