BENEFITS AND CREDITS

2. The benefits relevant for the purposes of paragraph (i) of the definition of priority group in article 1(2) are—

- (a) council tax benefit⁽¹⁾;
- (b) housing benefit;
- (c) income support;
- (d) an income-based jobseeker's allowance⁽²⁾;
- (e) an attendance allowance;
- (f) a disability living allowance⁽³⁾;
- (g) a war disablement pension which includes—
 - (i) a mobility supplement; or
 - (ii) a constant attendance allowance;
- (h) a disablement pension⁽⁴⁾ which includes a constant attendance allowance; and
- (i) state pension credit⁽⁵⁾.

(1) Council tax benefit, housing benefit and income support are provided for in Part VII of the 1992 Act.

(2) Jobseeker's allowance is provided for in Part I of the Jobseekers Act 1995 (c. 18): see in particular section 1(4) for a definition of "income-based jobseeker's allowance".

(3) Disability living allowance is provided for in Part III of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992 (c. 4); see in particular section 71.

(4) Disablement pensions are provided for in Part V of the 1992 Act; see in particular section 103.

(5) State pension credit is provided for in the State Pension Credit Act 2002 (c. 16).
