

SCHEDULE 4

Accommodation for Residential Care Licences

PART 2

Interpretation

England and Wales

6. Where accommodation for residential care comprises a group of specially provided dwellings, the dwellings which satisfy the requirements of paragraph 3(4)(a) to (c) must all be dwellings which are provided or managed—

- (a) under Part II of the Housing Act 1985⁽¹⁾;
- (b) by a housing association within the meaning of the Housing Associations Act 1985⁽²⁾; or
- (c) by a development corporation within the meaning of the New Towns Act 1981⁽³⁾.
