**The General Medical Services and Personal Medical Services
Transitional and Consequential Provisions Order 2004**

PART 2

**TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS RELATING
TO GENERAL MEDICAL SERVICES**

Independent nurse prescribers and supplementary prescribers

17.—(1) Where, on or before 31st March 2004, a relevant medical practitioner had notified the Primary Care Trust of any matters relating to an independent nurse prescriber or a supplementary prescriber under paragraph 28A of Schedule 2 to the 1992 Regulations⁽¹⁾, the succeeding contractor shall not be required to notify the Primary Care Trust of those same matters under—

- (a) the term of its general medical services contract which gives effect to paragraph 65 of Schedule 6 to the 2004 Regulations; or
- (b) the equivalent term of its default contract.

(2) In paragraph (1), “independent nurse prescriber” and “supplementary prescriber” have the same meaning as in paragraph 1 of Schedule 2 to the 1992 Regulations⁽²⁾.
