## The Detergents Regulations 2005

PROSPECTIVE

### Power of entry

**11.** An authorised officer shall have the right at all reasonable hours to enter any premises (excluding premises used only as a dwelling) for the purpose of ascertaining whether there is or has been on the premises any contravention, or any evidence of a contravention, of regulation 6, 7 or 8 or of a directly applicable provision of Regulation 648/2004 in relation to a controlled product.
