## **SCHEDULE**

Regulation 11

## **BUS LANE ADJUDICATORS**

- 1. To be qualified for appointment as a bus lane adjudicator, a person must have a 5 year general qualification (within the meaning of section 71 of the Courts and Legal Services Act 1990(1)).
- **2.** A person may be appointed as a bus lane adjudicator notwithstanding that he is appointed to act as a parking adjudicator for the purposes of Part 2 of the Road Traffic Act 1991(2).
- **3.** A bus lane adjudicator shall be appointed for such term, not exceeding five years, as may be specified in the instrument of appointment.
- **4.** On the expiry of his term of appointment, a bus lane adjudicator shall be eligible for reappointment.
- **5.** A bus lane adjudicator may be removed from office only for misconduct or on the ground that he is unable or unfit to discharge his functions but shall otherwise hold and vacate office in accordance with the terms of his appointment.
