

SCHEDULE 2

Classes of Harm

Class I

1. A Class I harm is such extreme harm as is reasonably foreseeable as a result of the hazard in question, including—

- (a) death from any cause;
- (b) lung cancer;
- (c) mesothelioma and other malignant tumours;
- (d) permanent paralysis below the neck;
- (e) regular severe pneumonia;
- (f) permanent loss of consciousness;
- (g) 80% burn injuries.
