**The Clean Neighbourhoods and Environment  
Act 2005 (Commencement No. 3) Order 2005**

The Secretary of State for Culture, Media and Sport, in exercise of the powers conferred upon her by section 108(3) of the Clean Neighbourhoods and Environment Act 2005<sup>(1)</sup> hereby makes the following Order:

**Citation**

1. This Order may be cited as the Clean Neighbourhoods and Environment Act 2005 (Commencement No. 3) Order 2005.

**Provisions coming into force on 1 January 2006**

2. The following provisions of the Clean Neighbourhoods and Environment Act 2005 shall come into force on 1 January 2006:

- Part 8 including Schedules 2 and 3;
- Part 8 of Schedule 5.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order provides for the coming into force of certain provisions of the Clean Neighbourhoods and Environment Act 2005 on 1 January 2006. The provisions are listed in article 2 of the Order. The provisions all relate to the creation of a new Commission for Architecture and the Built Environment and the dissolution of the old Commission.
