INTERNATIONAL CO-OPERATION

Overseas record

32.9.—(1) The overseas records of a magistrates' court shall be part of the register (within the meaning of section 150(1) of the Magistrates' Courts Act 1980(1)) and shall be kept in a separate book.

- (2) The overseas records of any court shall not be open to inspection by any person except—
- (a) as authorised by the Secretary of State; or
 - (b) with the leave of the court.
