RETRIAL FOLLOWING ACQUITTAL FOR SERIOUS OFFENCE

Notice of the determination of the application

- **41.13.**—(1) The Court of Appeal may give its determination of the section 76 application at the conclusion of the hearing.
- (2) If determination is reserved, the Registrar shall as soon as practicable, serve notice of the determination on the parties to the section 76 application.
- (3) If the Court of Appeal orders under section 77 of the Criminal Justice Act 2003(1) that a retrial take place, the Registrar must as soon as practicable, serve notice on the Crown Court officer at the appropriate place of retrial.
