**PART 63**

**APPEAL TO THE CROWN COURT AGAINST CONVICTION OR SENTENCE**

**Entry of appeal and notice of hearing**

**63.4.** On receiving notice of appeal, the Crown Court officer shall enter the appeal and give notice of the time and place of the hearing to—

- (a) the appellant;
- (b) any other party to the appeal; and
- (c) the magistrates' court officer.
