The Electricity (Fuel Mix Disclosure) Regulations 2005

Citation, commencement and extent

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Electricity (Fuel Mix Disclosure) Regulations 2005 and shall come into force on 18th March 2005.
 - (2) These Regulations do not extend to Northern Ireland.

Modification of electricity supply licences

- **2.**—(1) The standard conditions of electricity supply licences are modified by the insertion of the standard condition appearing in the Schedule.
- (2) The conditions which by virtue of section 33 of the Utilities Act 2000 MI are the standard conditions for the purposes of electricity supply licences granted after these Regulations come into force are modified by the insertion of the standard condition appearing in the Schedule.
- (3) In this regulation, "electricity supply licence" means a licence granted under section 6(1)(d) of the Electricity Act 1989 M2.
