The Hazardous Waste (England and Wales) Regulations 2005

**PART 4**

MIXING HAZARDOUS WASTE

**Meaning of mixing hazardous waste**

**18.** For the purposes of these Regulations, hazardous waste of any description shall be considered to have been mixed if it has been [<sup>F1</sup>diluted or has been] mixed with—

- (a) a different category of hazardous waste;
- [<sup>F2</sup>(aa) in the case of hazardous waste comprising waste oil, waste oil of different characteristics;]
- (b) a non-hazardous waste; or
- (c) any other substance or material.
