**Enforcement**

5.—(1) The Civil Aviation Authority shall be the designated body for the purposes of Article 16(1).

[<sup>F1</sup>(2) The Civil Aviation Authority and, subject to paragraph (4), the bodies listed in paragraph (3) shall be designated bodies for the purposes of Article 16(2).]

[<sup>F1</sup>(3) The bodies referred to in paragraph (2) are—

- (b) Consumer Dispute Resolution Limited (company registration number 09189773).]

[<sup>F1</sup>(4) The designation by paragraph (2) of a body listed in paragraph (3) only applies in so far as any contract entered into by that body with an operating air carrier provides for that body to deal with complaints made in accordance with Article 16(2) in relation to that carrier.]
