### The Housing Benefit Regulations 2006

#### PART 4

#### Membership of a family

#### Persons of prescribed description

**19.**—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), a person of a prescribed description for the purposes of section 137(1) of the Act as it applies to housing benefit (definition of family) is a person [<sup>F1</sup>who falls within the definition of qualifying young person in section 142 of the Act (child and qualifying young person)], and in these Regulations such a person is referred to as a "young person".

- (2) Paragraph (1) shall not apply to a person who is—
  - (a) on income support[<sup>F2</sup>, an income-based jobseeker's allowance or an income-related employment and support allowance]; <sup>F3</sup>...
- - (c) a person to whom section 6 of the Children (Leaving Care) Act 2000<sup>M1</sup> (exclusion from benefits) applies[<sup>F5</sup>; or
  - (d) entitled to an award of universal credit]

(3) A person of a prescribed description for the purposes of section 137(1) of the Act as it applies to housing benefit (definition of the family) includes a child or young person in respect of whom section 145A of that Act<sup>M2</sup> applies for the purposes of entitlement to child benefit but only for the period prescribed under section 145A(1) of that Act.
