OTHER CONSEQUENTIAL AMENDMENTS

PART 1

Consequential amendments to primary legislation

The Consumer Protection Act 1987

7. In subsection (1) of section 19 of the Consumer Protection Act 1987(1)(interpretation of Part II) in the definition of “licensed medicinal product”—

(a) at the end of paragraph (a) omit the word “or”; and

(b) at the end of paragraph (b) add—

“or

(c) a veterinary medicinal product that has a marketing authorisation under the Veterinary Medicines Regulations 2006.”
