Application of Leases Act 1449

- 73.—(1) Notwithstanding any rule of law to the contrary, any contract entered into in writing for a consideration and for a period of not less than a year whereby an owner of land to which a right of fishing for freshwater fish in any inland waters pertains or the occupier of such a right authorises another person to so fish shall be deemed to be a lease to which the Leases Act 1449(1) applies, and the right of fishing so authorised shall, for the purposes of succession to that right, be deemed to be heritable property.
 - (2) In this article "inland waters" does not include the tidal parts of the district.
